Tongues – attacked – prayers shape – build – min to you
Personal helper – 24 hr- work-study-rel-struggles

Overcome your weaknesses

Supernatural **Guidance**

Problem: signs –formula - **person**

He guides us not with magical **signs** or formula or mechanical methods but in **Person**.

Eph 6:17

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 (ΩΧΘ - **BY MEANS OF**) praying **always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints – NKJV

Pray in the spirit – turn logos into rhema **Sam? ministering** – praying – **resting** – way to **recog**

1. He guides us **primarily** through the Rhema of His **Word**

Jos 1 8 good success

Psa 1 Whatever he does prospers.

Whatever - Not just – ministers-Doc – lawyer – homemaker

99 – temptation – if Jesus – What clear - stop praying – start obeying

2. He guides us through the Rhema of **creative ideas Image - Great idea?- where – most brilliant**

Which? – Bible? Peace?

Anything – **TROUBLED** – don't go for it – **manipulate** – emo – **reli:**

giving, business, ma **die - Thus says - prophecy**
If feel – like **obligated** – forced into it – not of God

God **respects** your desires and choices

He gives you the **choice** God will never **by pass** the courtship process – process of **attraction**
No such thing as: No choice loh – got to sacrifice loh

Warm and gentle - like Jesus – warm – reassuring

Saul Saul – Martha Martha – Simon Simon – gentle – even

Even if correction – filled w compassion – why – so little faith
Rebuked them for not believing for more

Not asking too much

1 Corinthians 14:4

4 He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.

Diff be OT and NT

Prophecy that **judge** – reject it

Noah – drunk – Ham-Shem-Japheth
Gen 9:20-25

20 After the Flood, Noah became a farmer and planted a vineyard. 21 One day he became drunk on some wine he had made and lay naked in his tent. 22 Ham, the father of Canaan, saw that his father was naked and went outside and told his brothers. 23 Shem and Japheth took a robe, held it over their shoulders, walked backward into the tent, and covered their father's naked body. As they did this, they looked the other way so they wouldn't see him naked. 24 When Noah woke up from his drunken stupor, he learned what Ham, his youngest son, had done. 25 Then he cursed the descendants of Canaan, the son of Ham:

Supernatural walk - How to walk in the spirit in your **daily** life?

Romans 7:6

6 *But now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and not in the old way of the written code.*

6 But now we are discharged from the Law and have terminated all intercourse with it, having died to what once restrained and held us captive. So now we serve not under [obedience to] the old code of written regulations, but [under obedience to the promptings] of the Spirit in newness [of life]. AMP

Law is needed to restrain evil but it does not change hearts.

What is the purpose and limitations of the law?

Any country

Any country – world – need proper set of laws

Protect lives and maintain order

But it cannot **change heart** – **man adultery**

A man can don't commit adultery but not because of love

Out of fear – no opportunity – no money

Pas visit church members – no response

Rev 3 20 – Walk away

Same Sun - Genesis 3:10

I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

I. Walk by the Spirit, you will be freed from the slavery of the OT laws

Galatians 3:10

For as many as are of the **works** of the **law** are under the curse; for it is written, "**Cursed** is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them."

Why is a life under the OT law so frustrating?

Works of law Not – flesh? Life of curse and struggles

Notice: not works of **flesh** like adultery, murder

Even good works – done thinking – make you right with God

Romans 7:15

For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I **will** to do, that I do **not** practice; but what I hate, that I do.

7 "I" 32 times 8 2 times

Rom 7:24-8:1

24 Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin? 25 Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin. NLT

Focus on what I can do - LAW – frustrating – why?

Romans 3:20

20 Therefore no-one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become **conscious** of sin.

The Law tells us where we are wrong but does not give us the power to overcome sin.

Thou shall not be bald – how?

Receive the hair

In fact, the Law arouses our sinful nature!

Romans 7:5

For when we were in the flesh, the **sinful passions** which were **aroused** by the law were at work in our members to bear fruit to death.

Door - no trespasses – no peeping – strictly private - You only one in this hall

Which door – would you open - Why Aroused – by law

Girl – put down your leg –put up

Put up –put down

Ans to our frustration

Romans 8:1-4

1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in

Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in sinful man, 4 in order that the righteous requirements of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the sinful nature but according to the Spirit.

Rom 10:4-5

4 Christ is the **END** of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes

Galatians 1:6-7

Grace plus

6 I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel--

7 which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ.

OK to attend seminars – discern – Sam- in line

Great to **attend** seminars from other places – but exercise **discernment**

Anytime you hear any teaching that is not familiar – it doesn't sound like the familiar voice of the teaching you have receive so far – reject it. Otherwise you will be confused and robbed of blessing in Psa 133

When God speaks – one of the **clearest** way to **recog** – sound like – diff gospel

– Voice of God in you life – sound like the voice of the leaders

2004 – earth quake

in Singapore – that guy if OT – stoned – d happy to fulfil it – said – oh of God

OK seminars – don't force – couple – ask: what sin? Soln-hanging

Rather conc

OK to attend other seminars in other places but take care not to force a man to give you a prophecy Esp when you already have est prophetic ministries here, you may end up getting a word in the flesh Eg case of a couple getting a judgmental word Best conc on where you are and focus on winning souls

Before trip to Holy Land – warned of reli spirits – many groups going back to law

JESUS 1274 in NT – back to OT law/diet

Matthew 5:17

I did not come **TO** destroy (the law) but to **FULFILL**.

He came to fulfil the requirements of the law. For whom?

Fulfil **reqd** of law - **for** who? For **himself**? No He is already perfect For us

Die that we may live, cursed – that we may be blessed, the fulfil the law so that we don't have to depend on law for salvation

Grace does not mean lawlessness

On the contrary Uphold – so holy – only Jesus can fulfil it totally and entirely

FULFIL: Christ is the answer, solution to our "law problem". Christ NOW is the focus and not the OT laws.

Ans – end – soln – what the law cannot do

Not make law focus

Gal 3:24-25

24 Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. 25 But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. NKJV

Law points to Christ and not Christ points to law

What are some of the ways we very subtly go back to the law?

Colossians 2:15-19

15 And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

16 Therefore do not let anyone **judge** you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

Sun – Easter – pagan abused – redeem? - ang pow

Cannot worship on Sun only Sat Cannot celebrate Easter – pagan origin

True, but just becos pagan used and **abused** a day that God created – it doesn't mean it cannot be **redeemed** Just as angpow – now use to channel blessings and sp of generosity

17 These are a **shadow** of the things that were to come; the **REALITY**, however, is found in Christ.

Shadow – kiss pict of kids when kids around? Passover?

Christ came!

Why should we go back to the Jewish Passover when Christ already came. Shall we crucify Christ again?

We celebrate his resurrection on Easter and Sun

18 Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions.

Discern reli spirit – focus on minors – cannot this that - tail

19 He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together

by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.

2. Walk by the Spirit, you spontaneously do **more** things, freely, joyfully and happily

Gal 5:16

Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. NKJV

Romans 6:14

For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

Peo afraid - Under grace – enc sin – reality sin no power

Yet people afraid – grace will encourage sins

Nothing can be further from the truth Grace – in realm – sin has no power

Forgiven much – love much

Truth kept from people – people cannot love much!

Get up this building – stairs or lift

If you able body – fine – what if you are a cripple

Born in sin – spiritually crippled Grace is the lift

Greatest motivation for change

Philippians 2:13

... for it is God who works in you to will and to act according to his good purpose.

People say – **will** – way

When there is a will, there is a way

I am going – **diet** – stop **smoking** – **balloon**

Will can carry – **while** → **exhausted**

Like trying pull down group of **balloons** in water - tired - soon

No power in itself

Moses can sit in front of Red Sea – army – shout – I will overcome ...

If God didn't intervene – what happen

Self effort is useless without Christ's power

Man of God – used to love watch

TV – sports – every day – got home

One day, while watching – suddenly felt deep love for wife – went – embrace – felt so much love for you – feel like spending some time with you
Wife – replied – actually – said – many times – spend more time together – didn't listen

Did you? I didn't hear it
Problem with us man – we have selective hearing – somehow we don't hear what we don't want to hear

Wife continue: I just prayed this prayer:

Lord I give up – changing him by my effort - nagging – friends – if nagging works, many ma wouldn't have been broken

I can't but you can

Just that moment Holy Spirit – drop that love on the husband

A man tried to give up smoking

Can't – went to preacher – cried – don't try – you can't but Jesus can – caught the rev – lost the taste of cigarette

More relax – not doing out of fear – love – better job

Piano – play well at home but at performance make many mistakes

Confident - knowing - even fail - don't perform– still love

No sermon against smoking – chimney

make nose pointing down – not chimney – go heaven – go faster

Yet people – woke up – desire for smoking gone - behold

Won't even think of smoking
More try – worst become

Preach more against fear – guilt – worry – anxieties – than big sins

Root: Burnt out - exhausted – do stupid things

Guys - burnt out – watch out – tie self

Ezekiel 36:27

I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

Obey – not even conscious

Touched by grace, we obey the *spirit* of the law without even conscious of it.

Do – more than reqd of law!

Pas – how can I express love for my wife – 7 keys – day 1 card, 2 rose, 3 card, 4 dinner 40 min

some don't like – faint

led by Holy Spirit - as creative

– sent surprise SMS - holiday
Can you give me 10 keys/laws
Expect:

1 – send a card every month

2 – rose every week

Some loves flower – no flower one week – faint

Some don't like flowers – holiday
Obey the inner prompting of the Holy Spirit – do more – more creative ideas

What is the minimum – must give

– not curse – gratitude multiplies

Not curse – Christ cursed

Give out of love – more than 10

In his grace – he chose to give us more! – overflowing abundance

Warming in pool – singing in tongues

– not Packinson
rest and refreshing

Peace and joy

3. Walk by the Spirit, you will experience the extremely ABUNDANT LIFE.

John 10:10

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. KJV

Perissos: exceeding abundantly over and above, more than is necessary, superadded, superior, extraordinary, surpassing, uncommon, extreme, vehement, excessive, overflow, preeminence, superabundant (in quantity) or superior (in quality). *Thayer and Strong Greek Dictionaries.*

Who thief?

Context: Pool of siloam –

spit(cannot stand stench from dung gate) – go wash – pool of Siloam – sent- **throw out.**

John 9:16

16 Some of the Pharisees said, "This man is not from God, for he does not keep the Sabbath."

25 He replied, "Whether he is a sinner or not, I don't know. One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!"

28 Then they hurled insults at him and said, "You are this fellow's disciple! We are disciples of Moses!"

Who thief? Pharisees

Put a **heavy** burden on people – didn't help them

Law – what you must do – no help

Number **one thief – reli** spirit – **judge – Sept 11 – no better than the terrorist – saying same thing – thank you**

How does a reli spirit rob and steal and kill?

The Law excludes people but grace embraces.

Holy – unholy – steals

See yg peo-nose ring, don't cynical

Mark 6:34

34 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So he began teaching them many things.

Why like tht- act -so tough-

Look for love in **wrong** place – sheep **wout** shepherd

John 10:11

11 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

At the tomb – none came expect resurrection – Jesus told them

Expect dead body – bury

Yet after r – Peter – bored – go fishing – no catch

What Jesus did

Cold-fire

Hungry-breakfast

Discouraged – guilty - affirm

Love me? Feed my sheep

Make sure Peter knows He still

trust him, give him

responsibility – affirm him as leader

Not holding his fault - against him

We – historical – remind - think – spouse not do it again

More you think, meditate, dwell, talk past – more past **control**

More remind – more **do – fear –**

Job – what I greatly feared - **guilt**

Appendix: JESUS CHRIST

Matthew 1:21

21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

The Name "Jesus" (Iesous, occurring 1274 times in the NT) is the Greek equivalent of the Hebrew "Joshua" (yehoshua), meaning "Yahweh is **salvation**." It is translated in the Septuagint (Greek translation of the OT) as "Joshua." In Acts 7:45 and Heb 4:8 'Iesous' is translated as Joshua. Jesus is the personal name of the Lord in the Gospels and the Acts, but generally in the Epistles appears in combination with "Christ".

"Christ" (Christos) is the Greek equivalent of the Hebrew "Messiah" (mashiach) John 1:41; 4:25. It means "anointed". It designates Jesus as the Messiah prophesied in the Old Testament.
