knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. NKJV
Grace *χαρις*: enabling power, favour which
is unmerited.

Great to have best qualification – that alone –
wont promo – favor

Peace *ειρηνη*: prosperity, happiness,
security, rest, freedom from fear and strife,
wholeness, health.

World: got to Do more – Bible: **know see**
more

Strive – fight – if don't – nobody will fight for
you – do this that

And in Lystra a certain man without strength
in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his

intently and seeing that he had faith to be
healed, NKJV

Luke 5:1-7

Jesus – saw 2 boats – washing nets – got
into one – taught peo

1 One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake
of Gennesaret, with the people crowding
around him and listening to the word of God, 2
he saw at the water's edge two boats, left there
by the fishermen, who were washing their nets.

3 He got into one of the boats, the one
belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a
little from shore. Then he sat down and taught
the people from the boat.

4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to
Simon, "Launch out into the **deep** and let down
your **nets** for a catch." 5 But Simon answered
and said to Him, "Master, we have toiled all
night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your
word I will let down the **net**." NKJV

wants to do

God wants you have abundance but sm

Greatest enemy – mediocrity – false
contentment yes – happy with what you
have but good desire to have – more than
enough – be a blessing

But – not born with silver spoon – no
connection – no background

David - Abraham – rich – didn't start rich –
bef became – prosperous **mentality** - 23

Many are not – but will be – David –
shepherd boy – pros mentality 23

Young and old – Abraham Moses

Abraham, Isaac, Sol, David – not poor – rich
– yet very spiritual

Didn't start rich – made rich

Meanwhile, prosperous mentality – 23

David has a prosperous mentality bef - king

No worries – struggles but rest in God's supply
– tax – banker fish - garment

Why must we have a proper picture of
God?

But must have a **proper** picture – otherwise
– rob blessings

Luke 13:11-16

11 And behold, there was a woman who had a
spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent
over and could in no way raise herself up. 12
But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him

and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." 13 And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

Bent over 18 yrs

14 But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, "There are six days on which men ought to work; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day."

Rulers – angry – 6 days

15 The Lord then answered him and said, "Hypocrite! ... 16 So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound -- think of it -- for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?"

Show what God like

wrong picture – rob us of many blessings

First miracle – water into wine

Best wine – quality – 6 jars – abundance – wine - joy

So different – think what God is like:

God only bless us spiritually – don't want this health and wealth Gospel – impossible

– internet – tradi – museums - rob

BUT: He became poor that we thru his poverty might become rich – sp riches?

Impossible – if that is the case – it would mean – he became spiritually poor – that is blasphemous

Care of what you read – internet or some traditional commentaries

All the fear and suspicion can rob you of your inheritance

Or even museums! All kinds of pict of Christ

Skinny - sorrow - boring

First miracle – wine is a pict of celebration

– happiness – turn a **boring** life into something as intoxicating as wine

God wants us have **joy** of life

God wants us have the **best – abundance**

Blessed peter – net breaking – boat sinking experience – 12 baskets - 153 **large**

Rev 5:10

And have made us **kings** and **priests** to our God; And we shall **reign** on the earth." NKJV

Key to **reign**?

Romans 4:13

Revelation 5:1-10

John vision – scroll (Bible) – writing both sides – sealed – WHO worthy? **WEPT**

1 Then I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll with writing on both sides and sealed with seven seals. 2 And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming in a loud voice, "Who is worthy to break the seals and open the scroll?" 3 But no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth could open the scroll or even look inside it.

4 I wept and wept because no-one was found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside.

bef guy born – imagine king looking thru all the to CIA FBI secret reports

Reading – saw name – what purpose

2 Chron 36:23

23 "This is what Cyrus king of Persia says:

"The LORD, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and he has appointed me to build a temple for him at Jerusalem.

Ack God – source of his power

Ezra 6:3 The first thing the King did:

3 In the first year of King Cyrus, the king issued a decree concerning the temple of God in Jerusalem: Let the temple be rebuilt as a place to present sacrifices, and let its foundations be laid.

FIRST thing king did – decree – build God a house – result – became extraord king

they are sent

Similarly, you don't need to have **ALL**

Christians in your board

Joseph – was the only believer in Potiphar's
court and yet made Potiphar rich, becoss the
Lord was with Joseph – the presence of the
Lord

Exodus 4:2-4

So the LORD said to him, "What is that in
your hand?" He said, "A rod."

Tongkat - fortunately – name not Ali -

Angel - behold - here is a rod - made of solid
rubies, diamonds, sapphire

Not made in

– rubies, diamonds, sapphire – listen – this is
not made in Cambodia

Made in heaven – with this do great exploits –

Tail – let God handle **head** – most difficult –
control – let him be senior partner

Tail – not usual

joker get you - let God takes care of head - the
main issue

Exodus 4:20

took wife – return – M took r of God in his
hand

Then Moses ... returned to the land of Egypt.

And Moses took the **rod of God** in his hand.

Same rod – **Rod of God**

Same voice – talent – **miracle** – sea - rock

Voice of God – talents of God –

Rod – miracles – parted red sea – water out of
rock

Right where you are – give to the Lord

Zech 8:12

12 For I am planting seeds of peace and
prosperity among you. The grapevines will be
heavy with fruit. The earth will produce its
crops, and the heavens will release the dew.

these blessings. NLT

Context – have **nothing** – but when project
begun - flourish

Luke 5:6

And when they had done this, they caught a
great number of fish, and their net was
breaking.7 So they signaled to their partners in
the other boat to come and help them. And they
came and filled both the boats, so that they
began to sink. 8 When Simon Peter saw it, he
fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from
me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" NKJV

Peter – blessed – till **embarrassed** – depart
– sinful man

Jeremiah 33:7-9

7 I will bring Judah and Israel back from
captivity and will rebuild them as they were
before.

8 I will cleanse them from all the sin they have
committed against me and will **forgive** all their
sins of rebellion against me.

Again becoss of what Christ has done

9 Then this city will bring me renown, joy,
praise and honor before all nations on earth
that hear of all the good things I do for it; and
they will be in awe and will tremble at the
abundant prosperity and peace I provide for it.'

Note: peo of world – **tremble** at our
prosperity

– as we realise – sins forgiven – see him as Lamb
Cornie – unworthy feeling hinders
DO whatever he ask you - **embarrass**
Jesus **talks** more- why - repre
about money more than any other topic –
including **prayer, heaven** and **hell**. Half of all
the **parables** in the bible are about how we are
to manage money.
Money – rep our blood, sweat and tears, surely
how we spend money – reveals our heart

**Notice – just let Jesus use – a couple of
hours – blessed till embarrassed**

Not mean – full time – let him come into your
business – company – use for him
Not Christian sch – release teachers all sch –
bring love
