**Luke 4:16-22**

16 He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his **CUSTOM**. And he stood up to read.

17 The scroll of the prophet

Isaiah was handed to him.

Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:

18 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach **good news** to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim **freedom** for the prisoners and **recovery** of sight for the blind, to **release** the oppressed, 19 to **PROCLAIM** the year of the Lord's favour." 20 Then he rolled up the scroll (**closed** the book)

, gave it back to the attendant

and sat down. The eyes of

everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him,

21 and he began by saying to them, "**Today** this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." 22 All spoke well of him and were amazed at the **gracious** words that came from his lips.

"Isn't this Joseph's son?" they asked.

**Isaiah 61:2**

2 to proclaim the year of the LORD's favour and the day of vengeance of our God.

**Leviticus 25:8-10**

8 "Count off seven sabbaths of years--seven times seven years--so that the seven sabbaths of years amount to a period of forty-nine years. Then

9 ... you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the **Day of Atonement** you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.10 And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his **possession (property)**, and each of you shall return to his **family** (those sold as a slave). NKJV

**JUBILEE** Heb: jubilant, rejoice.

**Root word** – related to Heb: to blow or proclaim

Also related to: ram's horn or trumpet.

Teruah – ruah – breath

**Freedom** from slavery, debt, restoration of possessions, properties and relationships.

**Unique – no other nations have this practice**

It is the **50th** year after seven cycles of seven years.

**50 yr of independence**

Launch – from blow - after Day of atonement

Why is this year not exactly the year of Jubilee? Why need to sound? What to sound?

**Now** – this is **not exactly** the year of Ju!

Year to **sound** the Jubilee – **already** – since Jesus died

**NOTE** – could only have a

shopa on **Death** of a male lamb

Not perfect – but filtered – blood

3 pm – **cried** – out – it's finished

also at 3 pm – temple sopher

blow – **Atonement** - Passover

Psalms 89:15

15 Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, O LORD.

**Ps 89:14**

*Blessed are those who **hear** the joyful blast of the trumpet, for they shall walk in the light of your presence. TLB*

What to proclaim – what to hear?

Ans – what are we freed from – blood purchased – Christ

USA – slavery abolished –

many still in slavery – master

keep them ignorant – continue as slave for rest of life

**I. God wants you to be freed from debts, slavery, poverty**

Proclaim and hear - set free From **anything** that hinders your inc

Specifically, individuals who had incurred debts and had sold themselves as slaves or servants to others were released from their debts and were set at liberty.

**Entrepreneur Prayer, endless praise, weekly messages**

**Gal 3:3-5**

3 Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now

being made perfect by the flesh? ... 5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? NKJV

**2. God's Word will heal your vision**

**Luke 5:17**

17 One day as he was **teaching**, Pharisees and teachers of the law, who had come from every village of Galilee and from Judea and Jerusalem, were sitting there. And the power of the Lord was present for him to heal the sick.

Word is the key – **Germany** –

pastor sharing – churches –

Toronto movement – laughter –

just worship – rowing on floor -

not growing

Genuine move of God but no emph - word

Confirmation of my **observation** – just only having good time and "anointing" experience – not grow

Super churches – strong in word, release presence

**BUT** – not any word

What are the characteristics of Jesus' teaching of the Word?

**Luke 13:10-16**

Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.11 And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up.12 But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to

her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity."13 And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

14 But the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath; and he said to the crowd, "There are six days on which **men ought to work**; therefore come and be healed on them, and not on the Sabbath day."

15 The Lord then answered him and said, "Hypocrite! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath loose his ox or donkey from the stall, and lead it away to water it?16 So ought not this woman, being a **daughter of Abraham**, whom Satan has bound -- think of it -- for eighteen years, be **loosed (freed)** from this bond on the Sabbath?" NKJV

Woman – 18 yrs – **heard word** – not healed – why

**Not** words of grace – law -

How was she healed? – words of **grace** – Luke 4:19; 22

He closed the book (vengeance) He speaks words of grace Luke 24 27 things **concerning** himself

And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

All church – **same** – **will go heaven - true** – but it is

**impt to know** - **what** being taught – it will mean

Bondages or healing

Inc or false contentment

Greater vision or complacency

Poverty or abundance

Fulfillment or hopelessness

Sickness or health

How should we receive the Word?

**Impt** – don't **focus** – what you

**disagree** – rather – focus on

what God is saying to you – that's **why** – **the prophecy**:

Dhinar: Therefore as you **teach** them every **week, week** after week, I will **surely** bless them. **Riches** of the world is theirs.

**IPOD** – not just listen to rap music

Keep hearing the message, download from **NET**– like seed – **ting** – a revelation drop from head to heart

Life – vision

Sons of **reformation** – need to hear the message of grace again

**Heal your vision to see right opportunities**  
*Genesis 13:8-18*

8 So Abram said to Lot, "Let's not have any quarrelling between you and me, or between your herdsmen and mine, for we are brothers.

9 Is not the whole land before you? Let's part company. If you go to the left, I'll go to the right; if you go to the right, I'll go to the left."

*10 Lot looked up and saw that the whole plain of the Jordan was well watered, like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, towards Zoar. (This was before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah.)*

*11 So Lot chose for himself the whole plain of the Jordan and set out towards the east. The two men parted company:*

Prob: **Lot's choice** – only the surface –

**Like** garden of the Lord – not real

**Don't** go by what **you** can see

**miss** what **God** saw – corruption – season for judgment

In our **choice** – career – life

partner - which country to stay – kids – **MISS**

important don't go by what you can see – go by what God can see

If go by what we can see – miss God's prophetic time and season

God's **time** for Asia – great outpouring of Holy Spirit and wealth – **position** – right place Elder statement **LKY** – speak of - '**Asian Century**.'

Economically, there will be a shift to the Pacific from the Atlantic Ocean.

**Lois** – time for US- EUROPE- NOW Asia

**Goodnews!** - they have no choice – confronted with facts: asian countries – top in the GDP – gross domestic products

Highest respect for economists and accountants but God sometimes work amazingly

Despite – against all economic laws – stable govt, currency

Asian countries – top in GDP **Heal your vision to get wealth from right source**

*Genesis 14:17-24*

*17 After Abram returned from defeating Kedorlaomer and the kings allied with him, the king of Sodom came out to meet him in the King's Valley.*

*18 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. He was priest of God Most High,*

*19 and he blessed Abram, saying, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth.*

*20 And blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand." Then*

*Abram gave him a tenth of everything.*

*21 The king of Sodom said to Abram, "Give me the people and keep the goods for yourself."*

*22 But Abram said to the king of Sodom, "I have raised my hand to the LORD, God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth, and have taken an oath 23 that I will accept nothing belonging to you, not even a thread or the thong of a sandal, so that you will never be able to say, 'I made Abram rich.'*

*24 I will accept nothing but what my men have eaten and the share that belongs to the men who went with me-- to Aner, Eshcol and Mamre. Let them have their share."*

**Temptation** – get wealth from the **wrong** source

**You don't need God to be rich - enjoy**

– but you need God to enjoy your wealth

Fortune Magazine interview 400 – 70%, 10 yrs

of the riches men recently. 70% of them disappeared 10 years later.

Blessings of the Lord makes one rich – adds sorrow to it

**Self effort**

What are the differences between Esau and Jacob's blessings?

*Genesis 27:28-29*

*For Jacob:* May God give you of heaven's **dew** and of earth's **richness** -- an abundance of **grain** and new **wine**.

**DEW:** Sp blessing and favour – as if God knows – some would only take the spiritual ... he adds – earth riches

*29 May nations serve you and peoples bow down to you. ... May those who curse you be **curled** and those who bless you be blessed."*

**Dew** of heaven – spiritual b/favour

**Riches** of the earth – finan b

**Abundance** of grain – good food and health

**New wine** – joy

**Nations** serve and bow – lead - honour – respect

**Curse/cursed** – protection

**Deuteronomy 8:18**

18 "And you shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.  
NKJV

**Genesis 27:40**

By your **sword** you shall live, And you shall **serve** your brother; And it shall come to pass, when you become restless, That you shall break his yoke from your neck."

God's name not mentioned –

**you** – you you -you will

You will live by **sword** - **fight** for blessings

– whereas - Jacob – don't have to fight – God gives – till jealous!

Don't worry – God has a provision – curse those that curses you!

Pas, no choice what – world like this - **rat** race – even – only no 1 rat

### 3. God **enlarges** the vision of generous givers

**Genesis 15:1-4**

1 After this, the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward."

Came in a **vision**

First time word vision is used in Bible

Why **after giving**?

Abram earned the blessings?

No – already given vict – already very rich Genesis 13:2

2 Abram had become very wealthy in livestock and in silver and gold.

Key to discover **Greater** vision from God – **giving** heart. **Why**

Why does God bless and enlarge the vision of generous givers?

**God does not want us to end up with a "Esau" blessing**

Thinking we got our wealth thru self effort: that's why some don't

have a heart to give – we are angry with talks on giving

We wont enjoy our wealth – restlessness – strives with siblings

**God wants us to be whole with a heart of gratitude**

Most imp't char – **gratitude** - **whole**

**German** pastor – shared how

RLC – only one responded – immediately

He has gratitude – a thankful heart

**God can entrust the greatest riches to generous givers**

You don't **earn** blessings thru giving – grace but God can

**entrust** – greatest abundance

**Paris Hilton** – 97%

I am a king in the market place

– do you have a king's heart

**1 Chron 22:5-6**

5 Now David said, "Solomon my son is young and inexperienced, and the house to be built for the LORD must be **exceedingly** magnificent, famous and glorious throughout all countries. I will now make preparation for it." So David made abundant preparations before his death. NKJV

If we say we are kings in the market place, do we have a heart for the house of God – for the vessels, **instruments** and people of God's house

**Result :**

Notice – a heart for the house of God – **exceeding** – produces – exceeding results

**1 Chron 29:25**

25 So the LORD exalted Solomon **exceedingly** in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed on him such royal majesty as had not been on any king before him in Israel. NKJV

**2 Chron 1:1-2**

Now Solomon the son of David was strengthened in his kingdom, and the LORD his God was with him and exalted him **exceedingly**. NKJV

Ju – free from debts, poverty, slavery – experience all promises

**How** come – some Christians – so blessed with all these – some are not
