Judas - Dated much later –  
cultic - contra – hang – anti  
semitic?

The Gospel according to Judas  
is not acceptable as it quoted  
Jesus as saying that the God of  
Creation is **evil**. It was basically  
written by a **philosophical** cultic  
group (Gnostic) calling  
themselves Christians, dated  
much later than the 4 Gospels of  
the NT that were eye witness  
accounts of the life of Christ.  
There was an allegation that  
John was anti-Semitic. This is  
amazing, in view of the fact that  
John himself is a Jew! It was  
also mentioned that there is a  
discrepancy depicted in the 4  
Gospels, that in one account  
Judas hanged himself while in  
another account, he jumped into  
a valley. But both accounts  
could be true. The robe could  
have easily broken causing him  
to fall into the valley.

Inherit

1 Samuel 3:1 Word rare

1 Samuel 4:1 Philistine came

Parable of **sower** – wayside –  
rocky – thorny ground – **d\_-**  
**know - tree - hund**

D comes immediately – steal  
word – trials

Passion – da vinci – judas –  
opport to answer and release  
the truth – no fear – you have  
the truth in your hand!

*Luke 8:15 ...*

And as for that in the good soil,  
they are those who, hearing the

word, hold it fast in an honest and  
good heart, and bring forth fruit  
with patience. RSV

If hold on - takes root – your  
life never be same – higher -  
100 fold - stop

Moment takes root – move to  
higher ground in life – stop it  
bef it takes root

Once rooted, harder for d to  
take seeds!

Let us bring the ark of the  
covenant to us, **it** may save  
us from the hand of our  
enemies."

When – tried bring ark –  
another greater catastrophe  
Ark captured – Sons and Eli  
died - why

**Ano – catas - WHY - Called –  
IT**

– **furniture** - magic – ritual –  
**recog** presence  
Don't recog the **PRESENCE** of  
the Lord

Don't benefit – don't recog  
presence

Friend sick – just HC - **listen**

HC – friend or relative sick –  
listen to tape  
Just a furniture – magic – ritual

How **benefit** most HC

**I. By faith you receive what  
Christ has done for you**

Take and eat – faith – receive  
– **Q – deserve – will? Ress**  
– **fully paid**

Any **question** we deserve?  
When - proclaim – my body  
broken - **Q settled - know**  
Sickness – problem – feel we  
**deserve** it – our mistakes, sins,  
blunders, - hey Jesus took all  
the punishments  
Anytime, we have any  
**questions** – **proclaim** – he paid  
the price  
God would heal, deliver,  
prosper, forgive – that question

is settled – his body broken  
for you

*Isaiah 53:5b ... And by His  
stripes we are healed.*

**Soaked – 12**

Christ's body – **soaked** with  
health and power  
Anyone touched healed –  
bleeding 12 years

**Children's bread - prophetic**  
*Mark 7:27-29*

**1. You experience victory  
in the place of your defeat**

**Samuel – suckling lamb –  
burnt offering – like the HC  
- Ebenezer**

Ebenezer – place defeated -  
became

**Stone of help – Christ**

– God helped peo of God  
win over

**2. You receive Power to  
overcome sins**

**Trial – quiet – are you Christ  
– I am**

*Mark 14:61-63*

61 But He kept silent and  
answered nothing.

Again the high priest asked  
Him, saying to Him, "Are You  
the Christ, the Son of the  
Blessed?" 62 Jesus said, "I am.  
And you will see the Son of  
Man sitting at the right hand of  
the Power, and coming with the  
clouds of heaven." 63 Then the  
high priest tore his clothes and  
said, "What further need do we  
have of witnesses? NKJV

**HP – tore clothing – spit –  
common?**

Common? By law – cannot  
tear

**Symbolise ending of the OT  
Priesthood - bef the true  
HP, the corrupted HP,**

broke his own law – tear  
symbol of his office – gown  
Symbolise ending of the law  
along w its **curse** –  
beginning of grace – **M**  
came - Bread and wine –  
blessed A, min of blessings  
*Galatians 3:10*

For as many as are of the works  
of the law are under the curse;  
for it is written, "Cursed is  
everyone who does not continue  
in all things which are written in  
the book of the law, to do them."  
*Galatians 3:13*

13 Christ has redeemed us from  
the curse of the law, having  
become a curse for us (for it is  
written, "Cursed is everyone who  
hangs on a tree").

*Cf. Hebrews 7:1-3; Genesis  
14:17-20*

*Romans 10:4 For Christ is  
the end of the law for  
righteousness to everyone  
who believes. NKJV*

**Why law given? Restrain but  
cannot change heart - man**

Why was the Law given?

Law is needed to **restrain** evil

Any country – world – need

proper set of laws

Protect lives and maintain order

But cannot **change heart**

A man can don't commit

adultery but not because of  
love

Out of fear – no opportunity –  
no money

*Rom 7:5 For when we were  
controlled by the sinful nature,  
the sinful passions aroused by  
the law were at work in our  
bodies, so that we bore fruit  
for death. NIV*

**Law – thou shall not this –  
that**

**Door - no trespasses – no  
peeping**

– strictly private - You only  
one in this hall

Which door – would you open -  
Why  
Aroused – by law  
Girl – put down your leg –put  
up  
Put up –put down

*Hebrews 10:2 ... For the  
worshippers, once purified,  
would have had no more  
consciousness of sins. NKJV*

Focus on sins – undermine  
power of the blood!

**Through Christ, we don't  
have to be sins conscious**

Pas – why bible – confess our  
sins

How can we be obsessed with self  
examination?

*1 John 1:9 If we confess our  
sins, He is faithful and just to  
forgive us our sins and to  
cleanse us from all  
unrighteousness. NKJV*

Not recall – keep digging –  
past

Not be obsessed with morbid  
self examination - after 6 hrs  
– d still whisper – one more  
sin not confessed

Cf John 1 12

We don't receive Jesus every  
day all over again

This is not to introduce a new  
law – confession of sin but to  
assure us of forgiveness whenever  
we feel guilty of any sins.

When d does condemn – God  
provided soln – faithful and  
**just – overpaid – do justice**

To what Christ has done

In what way the devil is the accuser  
of the brethren?

d – **accuser** of the brethren –  
**Job - right**

accuses us bef God but now  
accuses our conscience – after  
cross – that pict no longer valid  
– thrown out  
right to enter – in Job's time –  
not as a prosecutor but as  
witness – to accuse us of our

sins. Now – all sins fully paid  
by Christ

**Revelation 12:9-10**

9 So the great dragon ... Satan  
(*accuser*), who deceives the  
whole world; he was cast to the  
earth, ...

10 Then I heard a loud voice  
saying in heaven, "Now salvation,  
and strength, and the kingdom of  
our God, and the power of His  
Christ have come, for the accuser  
of our brethren, who accused  
them before our God day and  
night, has been cast down.

D – there may be one more  
sin not confessed – freeze us

Rom 8:1 Therefore, there is  
now no condemnation for  
those who are in Christ  
Jesus. NIV

**Repentance?** – all time –  
change – whole service

What about **repentance**? Goes  
on all the time – pre service  
meditation – songs – testimony  
– Word – God focus on diff  
area – diff Sunday – *repentance*  
*GK = change of mind*

Whole service is a preparation  
towards to climax – receiving  
Christ's assurance in the HC

*1 Cor 11:27 Therefore  
whoever eats this bread or  
drinks this cup of the Lord in  
an unworthy manner will be  
guilty of the body and blood of  
the Lord. 28 But let a man  
examine himself, and so let  
him eat of the bread and drink  
of the cup.*

31 For if we would judge  
ourselves, we would not be  
judged. 32 But when we are  
judged, we are chastened (*child  
trained – paideuometha*) by the  
Lord, that we may not be  
**condemned** (*katakrimo – eternal  
damnation*) with the world.

*30 For this reason many are  
weak and sick among you,  
and many sleep.*

1 year – fear – born no fools

Pas friend of mine – early  
years – so fearful – never take  
for **one** year – just in case  
His mo didn't born no fools  
Fear – **rob** of blessing

**FACT: World already in a  
state of decay - sicknesses  
and diseases**

Christ body is the key to  
overcome

We make the Lord's Supper  
**responsible** - actually –  
answer

Take this medicine – heal

Don't take medicine - did the  
medicine kill you

**Tithe**

27 Unworthily – **adverb** –  
describe the **action** – not  
**person** - Unworthy manner

Context v 33 – 34

...hungry?

33 Therefore, my brethren,  
when you come together to eat,  
wait for one another. 34 But if  
anyone is hungry, let him eat at  
home, lest you come together  
for judgment. NKJV

**Early church – ...RLC buffet  
line**

eating and drinking greedily –  
you see some of this in our  
buffet lines – buy one ticket –  
bring in all the children

*29 For he who eats and  
drinks in an unworthy  
manner eats and drinks  
judgment to himself, not  
discerning the Lord's body.*

**Didn't discern the body** v 29  
just bread and wine

Christ's is present in a **real  
way**

**Sin consciousness is the  
major hindrance of our  
blessings.**

Why?

*Genesis 3:10 So he said, "I  
heard Your voice in the  
garden, and I was afraid  
because I was naked; and I  
hid myself."*

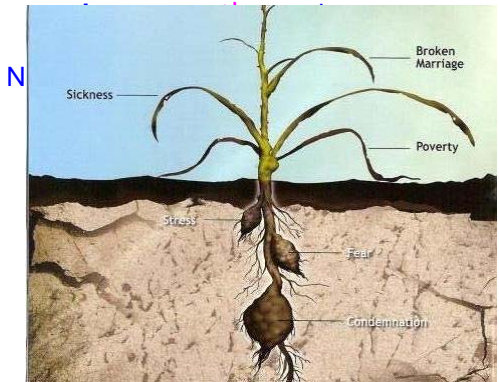
NKJV

**Fear** – hide – stress –  
sickness, rel problem -  
poverty

*Genesis 3:19 In the sweat of  
your face you shall eat bread*

Every time - face problem –

**what sins committed –**



*Rom 7:5 ... the sinful  
passions aroused by the law  
... bore fruit for death. NIV*

If you spouse hurt you –  
unfaithful

If you keep on digging into the  
past – it only brings  
condemnation – result is more  
sins  
After all I am not good – so –  
sin more!

**i. Transformed?**

*2 Corinthians 3:18 But we  
all, with unveiled face,  
beholding as in a mirror the  
glory of the Lord, are being  
transformed into the same  
image from glory to glory, just  
as by the Spirit of the Lord.  
NKJV*

What are the roots that we have to  
deal with?

Not sermon against **smoking** –  
chimney

make nose pointing down – not  
chimney – go heaven – go  
faster

Preach more against fear –  
guilt – worry – anxieties –  
than *big sins*

Cause peo – do – things like  
adultery – lies – cheating, etc

**Yet people – woke up –  
desire for smoking gone -  
behold**

Won't even think of smoking  
More try – worst become

We are not for sins – like ...  
etc

Dealing with the root!

Not just enough to give  
panadol – need antibiotics

Heaven – most beautiful –  
Jesus

Luke 7:36-46

Then one of the Pharisees asked  
Him to eat with him. And He  
went to the Pharisee's house,  
and sat down to eat.<sup>37</sup> And  
behold, a woman in the city who  
was a sinner, when she knew  
that Jesus sat at the table in the  
Pharisee's house, brought an  
alabaster flask of fragrant oil,<sup>38</sup>  
and stood at His feet behind  
Him weeping; and she began to  
wash His feet with her tears, and  
wiped them with the hair of her  
head; and she  
kissed His feet and anointed  
them with the fragrant oil.<sup>39</sup>

Now when the Pharisee who had  
invited Him saw this, he spoke  
to himself, saying, "This Man, if  
He were a prophet, would know  
who and what manner of woman  
this is who is touching Him, for  
she is a sinner."

<sup>40</sup> And Jesus answered and said  
to him, "Simon, I have  
something to say to you."

So he said, "Teacher, say it."

<sup>41</sup> "There was a certain creditor  
who had two debtors. one owed  
five hundred denarii, and the  
other fifty.<sup>42</sup> And when they  
had nothing with which to  
repay, he freely forgave them

both. Tell Me, therefore, which  
of them will love him more?"  
<sup>43</sup> Simon answered and said, "I  
suppose the one whom he  
forgave more."

And He said to him, "You have  
rightly judged."<sup>44</sup> Then He  
turned to the woman and said to  
Simon, "Do you see this  
woman? I entered your house;  
you gave Me no water for My  
feet, but she has washed My  
feet with her tears and wiped  
them with the hair of her  
head.<sup>45</sup> You gave Me no kiss,  
but this woman has not ceased  
to kiss My feet since the time I  
came in.<sup>46</sup> You did not anoint  
My head with oil, but this  
woman has anointed My feet  
with fragrant oil.NKJV

*Luke 7:47-48 "For this  
reason I say to you, her sins,  
which are many, have been  
forgiven, for she loved much;  
but he who is forgiven little,  
loves little." NAS*

**How can I forgive – he hurt me  
so terribly**

If you release the power of  
forgiveness, he will love you  
more terribly than before  
Zacchea ½ 4 Luke 19  
John – thunder to love

**Truth kept from people –  
people cannot love much!**

**Hindrance your growth**

*2 Peter 1:4-9 5 For this very  
reason do your best to add  
goodness to your faith; to your  
goodness add knowledge; 6 to  
your knowledge add self-  
control; to your self-control  
add endurance; to your  
endurance add godliness; 7 to  
your godliness add brotherly  
affection; and to your brotherly  
affection add love. 8 These  
are the qualities you need, and  
if you have them in  
abundance, they will make you  
active and effective in your  
knowledge of our Lord Jesus  
Christ. 9 But whoever does not  
have them is so shortsighted*

*that he cannot see and has  
forgotten that he has been  
purified from his past sins.  
TEV*

Add – godly char? Discipline  
– will power – law?

Why lack godliness–

forgotten – cleansed

More count **forgiven** – more  
godly virtue flow

Will power – flesh –  
disappointing

More count on God's

grace/**generosity** – more  
godly char will manifest –  
forget – forgiven

Grace – go from head to heart  
– transformed inside out

*Romans 6:14 For sin shall  
not have dominion over you,  
for you are not under law but  
under grace. NKJV*

Get up this building – stairs

or lift – able OK – wht if  
crippled

If you able body – fine – what  
if you are a cripple

Born in sin – spiritually  
crippled

Grace is the lift

Greatest motivation for  
change

*Numbers 21:9*

So Moses made a bronze  
serpent, and put it on a pole;  
and so it was, if a serpent had  
bitten anyone, when he **looked**  
at the bronze serpent, he lived.  
NKJV

**Rebel – bitten – did? - look -  
healed**

Rebel – against Moses

Bitten by snakes – dying

Did God send serpents? No

Desert already full of serpents

But when look – ser – lifted

high - healed

Medical world copy emblem

**Pict of Cross - serpent -  
bronze**

Serpent – sin

Bronze – judgment

See sins and disease on the  
cross -- lost power –  
healed

HC powerful act – empower –  
overcome sins
