Exo 15:26 ...I AM the Lord your healer.
RSV

God is your doctor and the medicine
he prescribes is the Word
Proverbs 4:20-22

20 My son, pay attention to what I say;
listen closely to my **words**. 21 Do not let
them out of your sight, keep them within
your heart; 22 for they are **life** to those
who find them and **medicine** to a man's
whole body.

Feed on the Word until it
penetrates your heart where it
deposits that **life** and power.

Psalms 107:20 He sent forth his **word**
and **healed** them; he **rescued** them from
the grave.

God's Word in it self is full of healing
power.

Jer 1:12 I AM **watching** over his word
to perform it. AMP

It is **not** a matter of whether it is
God's **will for** your healing. It is **not** a
matter whether you have enough
faith to be healed. It is the **power**
and **potency** of His word, his
medicine.

Joshua 1:8

8 Do not let this Book of the Law depart
from your **mouth**; meditate on it **day** and
night, so that you may be careful to do
everything written in it. Then you will be
prosperous and successful.

It is not enough to just believe in the
word. You have to **keep feeding on**
it. It is like food. What good is the food
if you just believe in food and not eat
it. Nutrition does not come by
memory.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of
faith

You have a **choice**: to speak what
God says or what circumstance
says or what the devil says.

You are **not denying reality** nor
the existence of the disease. You
are merely speaking what God has
promised and done in Christ..

You can confess like this:

Gen 6:3 For man's days will be a
hundred and twenty years.

God has promised that I will live a
blessed long life. I will not settle for
anything less than what God has
promised.

Gal 3:7 Those who are of faith are
sons of Abraham

In Christ I am a child of Abraham.
All of Abraham's blessings are mine.
Healing is part of the covenant.
Healing belongs to me

Prov 4:22 God's Words are **life** to
those who find them and **health** to a
man's whole body.

His Word is medicine to my flesh.
He is watching over this Word to
perform it. God's Word is full of
healing power.

My body has no choice but to
respond to God's healing power.
That power is spreading out of my
heart into every tissue of my body,
creating health and soundness.

Isa 53:4 Surely He hath borne my
sickness and diseases, and carried my
pains.

I don't have to bear what Jesus
has borne for me. By His stripes, I
was healed. My diseases went to
the cross with Jesus and died with
Him there.

Eph 1:19 The power that raised
Christ from the dead is at work in me.

That power is **irresistible**. It is
greater than sickness and disease.
Disease has **no choice** but to go.

It is not my faith nor my goodness
but his **power** in the word.

Note: please do not stop taking your
medication unless your doctor
instructs you to.

*Listen to the promises of the
Scriptures. Then make personal
faith confessions like these during
the pause:*

A. GOSPELS

1. Matthew 4:23

And Jesus went about all
Galilee, teaching in *the*
synagogues, preaching the gospel
of the kingdom, and healing all
kinds of sickness and all kinds of
disease among the people.

2. Matthew 7:7-8

7 "Ask, and it will be given to
you; seek, and you will find; knock,
and it will be opened to you. 8 For
everyone who asks receives, and
he who seeks finds, and to him
who knocks it will be opened.

3. Matthew 8:2-3

2 And behold, a leper came and
worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, if
You are willing, You can make me
clean."

3 Then Jesus put out His hand
and touched him, saying, "I am
willing; be cleansed." Immediately
his leprosy was cleansed.

4. Matthew 8:8,13

8 A centurion said, "Lord, I am
not worthy that You should come
under my roof. But only speak a
word, and my servant will be
healed.

13 Then Jesus said to the
centurion, "Go! It will be done just
as you believed it would." And his
servant was healed at that very
hour. NIV

5. Matthew 8:16-18

16 When evening had come,
they brought to Him many who
were demon-possessed. And He

cast out the spirits with a word, and
healed all who were sick,

17 This was to fulfill what was
spoken through the prophet Isaiah:
NIV

"He Himself took our infirmities
And bore our sicknesses."

6. Matthew 11:28

28 Come to Me, all you who labor
and are heavy laden, and I will give
you rest.

Rest is easy when we come to Jesus

7. Matthew 14:14

14 And when Jesus went out He
saw a great multitude; and He was
moved with compassion for them,
and healed their sick.

8. Matthew 15:22-28

22 A Canaanite woman came to
Jesus, crying, "Lord, Son of David,
have mercy on me! My daughter is
suffering terribly from demon-
possession.

26 He replied, "It is not right to
take the children's bread and toss it
to their *little* dogs."

27 And the woman said, "Yes,
Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the
crumbs which fall from their
masters' table."

28 Then Jesus answered and
said to her, "O woman, great is
your faith! **Let it be to you as you
desire.**" And her daughter was
healed from that very hour.

Jesus said:

Let it be to you as you desire.
Let it be to you as you desire.

9. Matthew 18:18-19

18 "Assuredly, I say to you,
whatever you bind on earth will be
bound in heaven, and whatever
you loose on earth will be loosed in
heaven.

10. Matthew 20:29-34

29 Now as they went out of
Jericho, a great multitude followed

Him.30 And behold, two blind men *were* sitting by the road. When they heard that Jesus was **passing** by, *they* cried out, saying, "Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!"

32 So Jesus stood still and called them,

32 ... *Jesus stood still*

and said, "What do you want Me to do for you?"

33 They said to Him, "Lord, that our eyes may be opened."34 So Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately they received sight, and they followed Him.

11. Mark 1:40-42

40 Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." 41 Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."42 As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.

12. Mark 5:22-34

22 And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet 23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, "My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live."24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and *pressed around* Him.

25 *And* a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years,26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse.

27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment.28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well." 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.

30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?"

... the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth.34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction. *Be made whole and healthy.*

13. Mark 5:35-40

35 *While Jesus was still speaking, some men came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue ruler. "Your daughter is dead," they said. "Why bother the teacher any more?"*

36 *Ignoring what they said, Jesus told the synagogue ruler, "FEAR NOT; ONLY believe."*

41 *He took her by the hand and said to her, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!". 42 Immediately the girl stood up and walked around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished. NIV*

14. Mark 6:56

56 Wherever He entered, into villages, cities, or the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might just touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched Him were made well.

15. Mark 9:14-27

17 Then one of the crowd ... said to *Jesus*, "Teacher, I *bring* You my son, who has a *deaf and* mute spirit.18 And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid.

22 And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." 23 Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."

24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"

25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it, "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!"26 Then the spirit cried out, convulsed him greatly, and came out of him. And he became as one dead, so that many said, "He is dead."

27 *But Jesus took him by the hand and helped him to his feet, and he stood up. NLT*

B. PROVERBS

16. Proverbs 3:7-8

7 Do not be wise in your own eyes;

Fear the LORD and depart from evil.

8 It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.

17. Proverbs 4:20-23

20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.

21 Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; 22 For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh. 23 Keep your

heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

23 *Be careful how you think; your life is shaped by your thoughts. TEV*

18. Proverbs 10:27

27 *The fear and worship of the LORD prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened.*

19. Proverbs 12:18

25 *An anxious heart weighs a man down, but a kind word cheers him up. NIV*

C. OLD TESTAMENT

20. Genesis 6:3

3 Then the LORD said, "My Spirit will not contend with man forever, for he is mortal; his days will be a hundred and twenty years."

God's Word says you can live to 120. Don't settle for anything less.

21. Exodus 3:7

I have indeed seen the misery of my people. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering.8 So I have come down to rescue them and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey.

22. Exodus 15:25-26

25 *Then Moses cried out to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a piece of wood. He threw it into the water, and the water became sweet.*

There the LORD made a decree and a law for them, and there he tested them. 26 He said, "If you listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I

brought on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, who heals you." NIV

23. Exodus 20:11

11 For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy, special and distinct. NIV
If God needs to take a day of rest so do you. The day of rest will refresh you and make you more productive.

24. Exodus 23:25

25 "So you shall worship and serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.

25. Leviticus 3:17

17 "This is a lasting ordinance for the generations to come, wherever you live: You must not eat any fat or any blood. NIV

26. Leviticus 11:46-47

46 "These are the regulations concerning animals, birds, every living thing that moves in the water and every creature that moves about on the ground. 47 You must distinguish between the unclean and the clean, between living creatures that may be eaten and those that may not be eaten." NIV

27. Deuteronomy 7:15

15 And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known ...

28. Deuteronomy 11:18-21

18 Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; ... 19 Teach them

to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 20 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates, 21 so that your days and the days of your children may be many in the land that the LORD swore to give your forefathers, as the days of heavens on the earth. NIV

Your days will be like heaven on earth.

29. Deuteronomy 28:1-14

3 You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country.

4 The fruit of your womb will be blessed, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock--the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks.

5 Your basket and your kneading trough will be blessed.

6 You will be blessed when you come in and blessed when you go out.

7 The LORD will grant that the enemies who rise up against you will be defeated before you. They will come at you from one direction but flee from you in seven.

8 The LORD will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The LORD your God will bless you in the land he is giving you.

9 The LORD will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways. 10 Then all the peoples on earth will see that you are called by the name of the LORD, and they will fear you.

11 The LORD will grant you abundant prosperity--in the fruit of your womb, the young of your

livestock and the crops of your ground--in the land he swore to your forefathers to give you.

12 The LORD will open the heavens, the storehouse of his bounty, to send rain on your land in season and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations but will borrow from none. 13 The LORD will make you the head, not the tail. If you pay attention to the commands of the LORD your God that I give you this day and carefully follow them, you will always be at the top, never at the bottom. NIV

30. Joshua 21:45

45 Not a word failed of any good thing which the LORD had spoken to the house of Israel. All came to pass.

31. 1 Kings 8:56

56 "Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised. There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which He promised through His servant Moses.

32. Neh 8:10

"Then he told them, "Go, eat rich foods, drink sweet drinks, and send portions to those who cannot provide for themselves. Today is a holy day for the Lord. Don't be sad because the joy you have in the LORD is your strength."

33. Isaiah 10:27

27 And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the **anointing**. KJV
... the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil. NKJV

34. Isaiah 40:31

31 But those who wait on the LORD

shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles,

They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

D. NEW TESTAMENT

35. Acts 3:16

Paul explains how a man crippled from birth was healed:

16 By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know ... was made strong. It is Jesus' name ... and the faith that comes through him ... that has given this complete healing to him, as you can all see. NIV

36. Acts 5:16

16 Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and **they were all healed**.

37. Acts 10:38

38 God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, and he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

38. Acts 13:38-39

38 "Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you.

39 Through him everyone who believes is justified from everything you could not be justified from by the law of Moses. NIV

39. Romans 4:17-21

17 Abraham believed in God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

whose command brings into being what did not exist. TEV

18 Abraham believed and hoped, even when there was no reason for hoping, and so became "the father of many nations."

For he holds on to the promise:

"Your descendants will be as many as the stars." TEV

19 And he was not weak in faith as he did not focus on his own body which was as good as dead now that he was about a hundred years old.

20 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, ... as his faith filled him with strength and ... as he gave praise to God

21 being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

40. Romans 5:9

9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

41. Romans 5:17

17 For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ. NIV

42. Romans 8:1-2

43. Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, 2 because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. NIV

44. Romans 8:11

11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit, who lives in you. NIV

45. Romans 8:31-34

31 If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

46. Romans 9:33

... whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame and disappointed.

47. Romans 10:8-10

8 But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: 9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved, delivered and healed. NIV

48. Romans 10:17

17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

49. Romans 11:29

29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

He will never go back on his promises. TLB

50. 1 Corinthians 9:27

Like an athlete I toughen my body, treating it with discipline, training it to do what it should, not what it wants to. I put it under submission, I master over its desires. Otherwise I fear that after enlisting others for the race, I myself might be unfit to finish the race.

51. 1 Corinthians 15:45

45 And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

Restoring the dead to life. AMP

52. 2 Corinthians 1:10

He has rescued us from a terrible death, and he will rescue us in the future. We are confident that he will continue to rescue us.

53. 2 Corinthians 1:19-22

20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him we speak with certainty - the "Amen" - to the glory of God.

21 Now it is God who makes us stand firm stand firm in Christ. And has anointed us.

22 He sets his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come. NIV

54. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

55. Galatians 3:13-14,29

13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us ... 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

29 And if you are of Christ, then you are a seed and descendant of Abraham, and heirs according to promise. All of God's promises to Abraham belong to us.

56. Ephesians 1:7

7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

57. Ephesians 1:17-19

17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

18 I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, NIV

19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power

58. Ephesians 2:1-6

1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, 4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions-- it is by grace you have been saved. NIV

6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

59. Ephesians 2:13

13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

60. Ephesians 3:16-21

16 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, 17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.

And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the

saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge-- that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. NIV

20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 21 to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

E. PSALMS

61. Psalms 1:1-3

1 Blessed is the man ... whose
2 ... delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. 3 He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water,

That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

62. Psalms 16:2-9

2 You are my Lord; apart from you I have no help. 5 The LORD is the portion of my inheritance & my cup; You guard my destiny and make my destiny secure. 6 Your inheritance have fallen to me in pleasant places; my heritage is delightful to me.

8 I am always aware of the LORD's presence; he is near, and nothing can shake me. TEV

9 And so I am thankful and glad, and I feel completely secure, 11 You will show me the path that leads to life; your presence fills me with joy and brings me pleasure forever.

For You will not abandon my soul to the world of dead; Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption or

decay. 10 because you protect me from the power of death.

I have served you faithfully, and you will not abandon me to the world of the dead.

11 You will make known to me the path that leads to life; In Your presence is fullness of joy (your presence fills me with joy); When you are near there are pleasures forever..

63. Psalms 20:1

May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble ! May the name of the God of Jacob set you {securely} on high ! 2 May He send you help from the sanctuary And support you from the sanctuary !

64. Psalms 22:3-4

3 But You are holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel. 4 Our fathers trusted in You; They trusted, and You delivered them.

65. Psalms 23:1-3

1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

He helps me do what honors him the most. LB

66. Psalms 27:4

One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek insistently: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord and in His presence all the days of my life, to behold and gaze upon His beauty, His sweetness, and delightful loveliness and to meditate in His temple. 5 For in the day of trouble He will hide me in His shelter; in the secret place of His tent; He will set me high upon a rock.

67. Psalms 27 8-13

My heart says of you, "Seek his face, favor, presence!" Your face, O LORD, I will seek.

13 I am still confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

68. Psalms 30:2

2 O LORD my God, I cried out to you for help, and you restored my health. NLT

69. Psalms 34:4

4 I sought the LORD, and He answered me, And delivered me from all my fears and terror. 5 They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces will never be ashamed.

6 This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him And saved him out of all his troubles. 8 Taste and see that the LORD is good, pleasant, and delightful. Blessed is the person who takes refuge in him.

9 O fear and worship the Lord, serve the LORD with joy you His saints; For to those who fear Him there is no want. 10 The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the LORD shall not be in want of any good thing.

12 Who is the man who desires life,

And loves many days, that he may see good? 13 Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit. 14 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

17 The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles.

18 The LORD is near to the humble, brokenhearted and the discouraged! He saves those who are crushed and lost all hope. 19

Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all.

20 He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken. 22 The LORD protects the souls of his servants. All who take refuge in him will never be condemned.

70. Psalms 41:3

3 The LORD will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed.

71. Psalms 49:15

God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall receive me.

72. Psalms 56:3-4

3 When I am afraid, I will trust in you. 4 In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid.

What can mortal man do to me? NIV

73. Psalms 62:7

7 "My salvation and my glory depend on God. God is the rock of my strength, my refuge." 8 "Trust him at all times, you people. Pour out your hearts to Him in his presence. Share with him your longings and troubles. God is our refuge.

74. Psalms 63:3,5

3 Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, My lips shall praise You. 5 My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips.

75. Psalms 67:5-6

5 Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You.

6 Then the earth shall yield her increase; God, our own God, shall bless us.

76. Psalms 68:19

19 Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens and loads us with benefits.

77. Psalms 84:11

For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. 12 O LORD Almighty, blessed is the man who trusts in you.

F. HOLY COMMUNION

78. Matthew 26:26-28

While they were eating, Jesus took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "**Take and eat; this is my body.**"

27 Then he took the cup, gave thanks and offered it to them, saying, "**Drink** from it, all of you. 28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. NIV

* He sent His Word and healed my diseases. (Ps 107:20)

* I will not die but live to proclaim what the Lord has done (Psa 118:17)

* The power of God is present to heal me. (Luke 5:17)

* Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law. (Gal 3:13)

* God is restoring my health and healing my wounds. (Jer 30:17)

* Jesus is the Lord who heals me. (Exo 15:26)

* My body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit, sickness cannot stay in me. (1 Cor 3:16)

* God desires me to be in good health. (3 John 2)

* Jesus has compassion on me and heals me. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. (Matt 14:14)

* I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. (Phil 4:13)

* As I cast all my cares and anxieties on him, the peace of God which passes all understanding will keep my heart and my mind focused on Jesus Christ. (Phil 4:7-8)

* The Lord will keep me in perfect peace because my mind is stayed on him and because I trust him. (Isa 26:3)

* I take the shield of faith and I quench every fiery dart that the wicked one brings against me. (Eph 6:16)

* Having received the gift of righteousness I reign as a king in life through the Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom 5:17, 19; II Tim 2:12)

* I am a new creation. All things have become new. The old has passed away. (II Cor 5:17)

The will of God is done on earth as it is done in heaven. There is no sickness in heaven; therefore, I am not sick at all on the earth. Jesus was never sick on this earth. Jesus is in me and His life flows in me. As He was in the world so am I in this world. I am healthy as Jesus was healthy upon this earth (Matt. 6:10; Gal. 2:20; 1 Jn. 4:17)

I believe, in Christ I am highly favoured. Everywhere I go, the favour of God is on me.

I am highly favoured, deeply loved and greatly blessed.

I am sealed with the Holy Spirit and healed 2000 years ago. For Jesus was wounded for my transgression.

He was crushed for my iniquities - by His stripes I am healed.

Surely He has borne all my sicknesses and carried all my diseases. Therefore I am freed from all sicknesses and diseases.

Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law. Therefore Christ has redeemed me from sicknesses, poverty, and death.

For sickness - He gave me health.

For poverty - He gave me wealth.

For death - He gave me His life. Hallelujah!

God is your doctor and the medicine He prescribes is the Word

Proverbs 4:20-22

20 My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my **words**. 21 Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; 22 for they are **life** to those who find them and **medicine** to a man's whole body.

Feed on the Word until it **penetrates** your heart where it **deposits** that **life** and power.

Psalms 107:20 He sent forth his **word** and **healed** them; he **rescued** them from the grave.

God's Word in it self is full of healing power. It is **not** a matter of whether it is God's **will** for your healing. It is **not** a matter whether you have enough **faith** to be healed. It is the **power** and **potency** of His word, His medicine. He is **watching** over His Word to perform it (Jer 1 12).

Joshua 1:8

8 Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your **mouth**; meditate on it **day and night**, ...

It is not enough to just believe in the Word. You have to **keep feeding on** it. It is like food. What good is the food if you just believe in food and not eat it. Nutrition does not come by memory.

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith

You have a **choice**: to speak what God says or what circumstance says or what the devil says.

You are **not denying reality** nor the existence of the disease. You are merely speaking what God has **promised** and **done** in Christ..

Gen 6:3 For man's days will be a hundred and twenty years.

God has promised that I will live a blessed long life. I will not settle for anything less than what God has promised.

Eph 1:19 The power that raised Christ from the dead is at work in me.

That power is **irresistible**. It is **greater** than sickness and disease. Disease has **no choice** but to go.

It is not my faith nor my goodness but his **power** in the word.
