A. GOSPELS

1. Mark 11:22-24

22 "Have the faith of God," Jesus answered. 23 Truly, I say to you, if anyone says and commands this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and does not doubt, question or think through it in his heart but believes that what he says will come to pass, he will have it. 24 Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask and request earnestly, ... having prayed, ... **believe**[imperative] that you received[once for all] them, ... you shall have them.

2. Mark 16:17-18

17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

3. Luke 5:17-25

17 One day as he was **teaching** preaching the word to them, ... the power of the Lord was present for him to heal the sick. 18 Some men came carrying a paralytic on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. 19 When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus.

20 When Jesus saw their faith, he said, "Friend, your sins are forgiven."

He said to the paralyzed man, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, go

home." 25 Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God. NIV

4. Luke 10:19

19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

5. Luke 12:32

32 "Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

6. Luke 13:11-13,16

11 And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity for eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. 12 But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity." 13 And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. 16 *he said* ... ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound ... for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?"

7. Luke 17:12-19

12 As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance 13 and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

14 When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed.

15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him-and he was a Samaritan.

17 Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other

nine? 18 Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner? NIV

19 And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you **WHOLE.**"

8. Luke 18:41-43

Jesus said: "What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight."

42 Then Jesus said to him, "**Then SEE!** Receive your sight; your faith has made you well." 43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God.

9. John 6:37

37 "All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

*I will most certainly not cast out. I will never, **no never**, reject one of them who comes to Me. AMP*

10. John 6:63

63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

11. John 8:32

32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

12. John 8:36

36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

13. John 9:1-3

1 As he went along, he saw a man blind from birth. 2 His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"

3 "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Jesus, "but this happened so that the work of

God might be displayed in his life. NIV

14. John 10:10

10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

15. John 14:12-14

12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these ... he will do, because I go to My Father.

13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

16. John 14:27

27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. NKJV

I don't give you the kind of peace that the world gives.

Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. NKJV

17. John 16:23-27

23 *In that day you will no longer ask me anything. I tell you the truth, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. 24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.*

26 *In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the Father on your behalf. 27 No, the Father himself loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from God. NIV*

B. PROVERBS

18. Proverbs 14:26-30

26 In the fear of the LORD there is strong confidence, And His children will have a place of refuge. 27 The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, To turn one away from the snares of death.

30 *A heart at peace gives life and makes the body healthy.*

But envy and wrath is rottenness to the bones.

A relaxed attitude lengthens a man's life TLB

19. Proverbs 15:4

4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But *harsh words break* the spirit.

20. Proverbs 15:13

13 A happy heart makes the face cheerful, but sorrow of the heart crushes the spirit.

21. Proverbs 16:24

24 Pleasant words are like a honeycomb, Sweetness to the soul and health to the bones.

22. Proverbs 17:22

22 A merry heart does good, like medicine, But a broken spirit dries the bones.

23. Proverbs 18:21

21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

24. Proverbs 21:23

23 Whoever guards his mouth and tongue Keeps his soul from troubles.

C. OLD TESTAMENT

25. Isaiah 41:10

10 Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God.

I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.'

26. Isaiah 43:1

Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you

are mine. 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze. 3 For I am the LORD, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. 4 Others died that you might live; I traded their lives for yours because you are precious to me and honored, and I love you.

27. Isaiah 43:25

25 "I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more. NIV

28. Isaiah 53:4-5

4 Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted.

5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wound we are healed. NIV

29. Isaiah 54:17

17 No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue which rises against you in judgment

You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD,

And their righteousness is from Me,"

Says the LORD.

30. Isaiah 55:10-11

10 As the rain and the snow come down from heaven,

and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, NIV

11 So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void,

But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

31. Isaiah 57:19

18 "I have seen how they acted, but I will heal them. I will lead them and help them, and I will comfort those who mourn. 19 I offer peace to all, both near and far! I will heal my people. TEV

32. Isaiah 58:6,8

6 "Is this not the fast that I have chosen: To loose the bonds of wickedness, To undo the heavy burdens, To let the oppressed go free, And that you break every yoke?

8 Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your healing shall spring forth speedily, And your righteousness shall go before you;

The glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard.

33. Isaiah 64 4

Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him.

34. Jeremiah 1:12

12 *The Lord to me, You have seen well, I am ready and hastening and watching over My word to perform it. AMP*

35. Jeremiah 29:11

11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD,

thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

12 *Then you will call upon me & pray to me & I will listen to you. Seek me & find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you & will bring you back from captivity.*

36. Jeremiah 30:17

17 For I will restore health to you And heal you of your wounds,' says the LORD, 'Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Jerusalem and no one cares for her.

37. Jeremiah 33:3

3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

38. Jeremiah 33:6-9

6 Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth. 7 And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first. 8 I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned and by which they have transgressed against Me. 9 Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'

39. Lamentations 3:22-23

22 Through the LORD's mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. 23 They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness.

40. Ezekiel 37:3-6

3 And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know."

4 Again He said to me, "Prophecy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD! Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live.6 I will put *tendons* on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the LORD.

41. Joel 3:10

... Let the weak say, 'I am strong.'

42. Zephaniah 3:15

The LORD has taken away and reversed your judgments. He has cast out your enemy. The King, the LORD, is lives in your midst; You shall fear disaster no more. JY

16 *The time is coming when they will say to Jerusalem, "Do not be afraid, city of Zion! Do not let your hands hang limp! 17 The LORD your God is with you; his power gives you victory. The LORD will take delight in you, and in his love he will give you new life. He will sing and be joyful over you, 18 as joyful as people at a festival." The LORD says, "I have ended the threat of doom and taken away your disgrace. TEV*

43. Nahum 1:9

9 What do you conspire against the LORD? He will make an utter end of it. Affliction will not rise up a second time.

44. Malachi 4:2-3

2 But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings. And you will go out and leap like calves released from the stall. 3 Then you will trample down the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I do these things," says the LORD Almighty.

D. NEW TESTAMENT

45. Ephesians 4:26-27

26 *"In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, 27 and do not give the devil a foothold. NIV*

46. Philippians 4:6-7

6 *Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.*

47. Colossians 1:12-14

12 Give thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and transported us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

48. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

16 *Be joyful always; 17 pray continually; NIV*

18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

49. 1 Timothy 1:14

Our Lord poured out his abundant grace on me and gave me the faith and love which are ours in union with Christ Jesus.

50. 2 Timothy 1:7

7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

51. Jude 1:1-2

Jude to those who have been called by God, who live in the love of God the Father and the protection of Jesus Christ: 2 May mercy, peace, and love be yours and be multiplied in full measure.

[When we live in God's love, we come under his protection. And enabling & prosperity will be multiplied.]

52. Hebrews 2:14

14 *Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death-- that is, the devil. NIV*

53. Hebrews 4:14

14 *Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. NIV*

Let us hold fast to our confession.

54. Hebrews 4:16

16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

55. Hebrews 7:18

The former regulation is set aside because it was weak and useless 19 (for the law made nothing perfect),

and a better hope is introduced, by which we draw near to God. 22 ...

*Jesus has become the **guarantee** of a better covenant. NIV*

56. Hebrews 7:22

So much the more also Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant.

25 *Therefore He is able also to save to the uttermost and completely, those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. NASB*

57. Hebrews 9:12

12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

58. Hebrews 10:23

23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

59. Hebrews 10:21-23

35 *So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.*

36 *You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. NIV*

60. Hebrews 11 1-2

1 *What is faith? It is the confident expectation that something we want is going to happen. It is the certainty and conviction that what we hope for is waiting for us, even though we cannot see it up ahead.*

2 *Men of God in days of old were commended for their faith.*

61. Hebrews 11:11

11 By faith Abraham, even though he was past age-- and Sarah herself was barren-- was enabled to become a father. NIV
because she considered God who has given her the promise to be reliable and trustworthy and true to his word. AMP

62. Hebrews 12:12-13

12 Lift up your tired hands, then, and strengthen your trembling knees!
13 Keep walking on straight paths, so that the lame foot may not be disabled, but instead be healed. TEV

63. Hebrews 13:8

8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

64. James 4:7-10

7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. 8 Come near to God and he will come near to you.
10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up. NIV

65. James 5:14-16

14 Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him, having anointed him with oil in the name of the Lord.
15 And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven.
16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. NIV

66. 1 Peter 2:24

24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness -- by whose *stripe* you were healed.

67. 1 Peter 5:6-9

6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,⁷ casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you. 8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.⁹ Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.

68. 2 Peter 1:3-4

3 His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. NIV
4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust and evil desires.

69. 1 John 1:9

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. NIV
As we are open to God with our weaknesses, we shall receive power to overcome those weaknesses.

70. 1 John 3:8

8b ...For this purpose the Son of God appeared, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

71. 1 John 4:4

4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

72. 1 John 4:16-17

16 And so we know and rely on the love God has for us.
God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. NIV
17 In this way, God's love has reached its goal in us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment.
... because as He is, so are we in this world.

73. 1 John 5:4

4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world -- our faith.

74. 3 John 2

2 Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.

75. Revelation 5:9-10

9 And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,
10 And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."

76. Revelation 12:11

11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.

E. PSALMS

77. Psalms 91:1-16

1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
2 I will say of the LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."
3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous

pestilence. 4 He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge;
His truth shall be your shield and buckler. 5 You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day, 6 Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. 7 A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; But it shall not come near you. 8 Only with your eyes shall you look, And see the reward of the wicked. 9 Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place,
10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;
11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. 12 In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. 13 You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra,
The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot. 14 "Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. 15 He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. 16 With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation."

78. Psalms 92:12-14

The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. 13 Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. 14 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be healthy, prosperous, full of life, flourishing fresh, green and flourishing.

79. Psalms 103:2-5

2 Bless the LORD, O my soul,
And forget not all His benefits:
3 Who forgives all your iniquities,
Who heals all your diseases,
4 Who redeems your life from destruction,
Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,
5 Who satisfies your mouth with good things,
So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

80. Psalms 103:8-13

8 The LORD is merciful and gracious,
Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.
9 He will not always strive with us,
Nor will He keep His anger forever.
10 He has not dealt with us according to our sins,
Nor punished us according to our iniquities.
11 For as the heavens are high above the earth,
So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him;
12 As far as the east is from the west,
So far has He removed our transgressions from us.
13 As a father pities his children,
So the LORD pities those who fear Him.

81. Psalms 105:37

37 He also brought them out with silver and gold,
And there was none feeble among His tribes.

82. Psalms 107:19-20

19 Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble,
And He saved them out of their distresses.
20 He sent His word and healed them,
And delivered them from their destructions and the grave.

83. Psalms 112:6

6 Surely he will not be shaken and be overthrown by evil circumstances.
God's constant care of him will make a deep impression on all who see it.
7 He does not fear bad news,
nor live in dread of what may happen.
For he is steadfast and settled in his mind that the Lord will take care of him.

84. Psalms 116:3-7

The ropes of death became tangled around me. I experienced pain & agony. 4 But I KEPT CALLING on the name of the LORD: I beseech You, save my life! 5 Gracious is the LORD & righteous; Yes, compassionate. 6 He saved me. 7 Be at peace again my soul 9 I will walk in the LORD'S presence in this world of the living. 85. Psalms 118:17

17 I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the LORD.

86. Psalms 119:18

18 Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous things from Your law.

116 Uphold me according to Your word,
that I may live; And do not let me be ashamed of my hope.

91. Psalms 121:7-8

7 The LORD shall preserve you from all evil;
He shall preserve your soul.
8 The LORD shall preserve your going out and your coming in
From this time forth, and even forevermore.

F. HOLY COMMUNION

92. Matthew 26:26-28

While they were eating, Jesus took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "**Take and eat; this is my body.**"

27 Then he took the cup, gave thanks and offered it to them, saying, "**Drink** from it, all of you.
28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.
NIV

93. John 6:32-33

32 Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you

the true bread from heaven. 33 For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives **life** to the world. NIV

94. John 6:51

51 I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live for ever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. NIV

95. John 6:53

53 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. NIV

96. 1 Peter 2:24

24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness -- by whose **stripe** you were healed.

97. 1 Corinthians 10:16

Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? NIV

98. 1 Corinthians 11:26

26 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. NIV

99. Numbers 21:9

So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he **looked** at the bronze serpent, he lived. NKJV

G. PROCLAIM THE WORD OVER YOUR LIFE

- * By His wounds I am healed (1 Pet 2:24)
- * Jesus took my infirmities and carried my sickness. (Matt. 8:17)
- * I bless the Lord for He has healed me of all my diseases (Psa 103:3)
- * He sent His Word and healed my diseases. (Ps 107:20)
- * I will not die but live to proclaim what the Lord has done (Psa 118:17)
- * The power of God is present to heal me. (Luke 5:17)
- * Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law. (Gal 3:13)
- * God is restoring my health and healing my wounds. (Jer 30:17)
- * Jesus is the Lord who heals me. (Exo 15:26)
- * My body is the Temple of the Holy Spirit, sickness cannot stay in me. (1 Cor 3:16)
- * God desires me to be in good health. (3 John 2)
- * Jesus has compassion on me and heals me. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. (Matt 14:14)
- * I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. (Phil 4:13)
- * As I cast all my cares and anxieties on him, the peace of God which passes all understanding will keep my heart and my mind focused on Jesus Christ. (Phil 4:7-8)
- * The Lord will keep me in perfect peace because my mind is stayed on him and because I trust him. (Isa 26:3)
- * I take the shield of faith and I quench every fiery dart that the wicked one brings against me. (Eph 6:16)
- * Having received the gift of righteousness I reign as a king in life through the Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom 5:17, 19; II Tim 2:12)

* I am a new creation. All things have become new. The old has passed away. (II Cor 5:17)

The will of God is done on earth as it is done in heaven. There is no sickness in heaven; therefore, I am not sick at all on the earth. Jesus was never sick on this earth.
