A. YOU BUILD WITH YOUR WORDS

Matthew 5:37

37 Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No!'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

There are many ways to erode trust

1. Lies.

Eph 1:6

6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us **accepted** in the Beloved.
NKJV

2. Flattery.

Psalms 12:3

3 May the LORD cut off all flattering lips and every boastful tongue.

3. Broken .

Psalms 15:4b ... who keeps his oath even when it **hurts**,

Ps 15:4b ...He always does what he promises, no matter how much it may **cost**. (TEV)

Ps 15:4b ...keeps a promise even if it **ruins him**, (TLB)

4. Silence.

B. YOU GUARD YOUR .

Proverbs 4:23

23 Above all else, **guard** your heart, for it is the wellspring of life.

Mark 7:15 "Your souls aren't harmed by what you eat but by what you think and say."

Matt 12:33-35

33 "A tree is **identified** by its **fruit**. A tree from a select variety produces good fruit; poor varieties don't. 34 You brood of snakes! How could evil men like you speak what is good and right? For a man's **heart determines his speech**. 35 A good man's speech **reveals** the rich treasures within him. An evil-hearted man is filled with venom, and his speech reveals it. TLB

Matt 12:33

Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree **corrupt**, and his fruit **corrupt**: for the tree is known by his fruit. KJV

Corrupt – means rotten, worthless, bad

Matt 12:33 ...for the tree is known and recognized and judged by its **fruit**. (AMP)

Matt 12:33 ...A tree is **identified** by its fruit... (NLT)

Matt. 12:33 ...A tree is known by the kind of fruit it **bears**. (TEV)

v.34 ...For the mouth **speaks out** of that which **fills** the heart. NAS

v.34 ...For whatever is in your heart **determines** what you say. (NLT)

34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the **abundance of the heart** the mouth speaketh. KJV

Evil- means hurtful, vicious, grievous, wicked, harm

Abundance- means over and above, superabundance

Matt 12:35 A good man's speech **reveals** the rich **treasures** within him. An evil-hearted man is filled with venom, and his speech reveals it TLB

Treasure – means deposit, wealth, conceive, purpose, set, commit

When we speak the truth in love, we will know when to speak, what to speak and how to speak.

Proverbs 18:21

Corrupt-means rotten, wicked, bad

edifying -means building a house

minister- means deliver, commit, give, have power, offer

grace -means benefit, favours, pleasure

Grieve-means to sorrow, distress, heaviness, to be sad

Proverbs 24:26

26 An honest answer is like a kiss on the lips.

Proverbs 27:6

6 Wounds from a friend can be trusted, but an enemy multiplies kisses.

Ephesians 4:15

15 Instead, **speaking the truth in love**, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ.

Proverbs 16:23

23 A wise man's heart guides his mouth, and his lips promote instruction.

Proverbs 21:23

23 He who guards his mouth and his tongue keeps himself from calamity.
