5. HOW TO INCREASE THE VALUE OF YOUR RELATIONSHIPS

A. WHY EXPRESS APPRECIATION?

1. Whatever you appreciate, it increases in

Ephesians 4:29

29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for **building** others up according to their **needs**, that it may benefit those who listen.

Proverbs 31:30-31

30 Charm is deceptive, and beauty is fleeting; but a woman who fears the LORD is to be praised.
31 Give her the reward she has earned, and let her works bring her praise at the city gate.

2. Whenever you appreciate - you also increase value!

1 Peter 3:7-8

7 Likewise you husbands, live considerately with your wives, bestowing honor on the woman as the **weaker** sex, since you are **joint** heirs of the grace of life, in order that your prayers may not be **hindered**. RSV

Ephesians 6:2-3

2 "Honour your father and mother"-- which is the first commandment with a promise--
3 "that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

Hebrews 13:7-17

C. HOW PAUL APPRECIATES HIS

Colossians 3:1-18

1. He clearly his need for his co-workers

Col 3:10

My fellow prisoner Aristarchus sends you his greetings, as does Mark, the cousin of Barnabas. (You have received instructions about him; if he comes to you, welcome him.) 11 Jesus, who is called Justus, also sends greetings. These are the only Jews among my fellow workers for the kingdom of God, and they have proved a comfort to me.

Col 3:9 He is coming with Onesimus, our **faithful** and dear brother, who is one of you. They will tell you everything that is happening here.
