Rom 5:17

For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness REIGN in life through the one man, Jesus Christ.

1. Power to build good
relationships

Guilt - damage your rel - why?
Harsh - spoil - fear (keep dist)
- stress (peo say or do)

Harsh & critical like

Pharisees - hard? Hard on themselves - think God is hard on them - got to work work work - frust

Harsh on peo - think God is harsh on them - press peo down - make themselves feel good

Spoil and indulge in people
Guilt - buy a lot of things

Fear Always worries - if know me - don't like - reject me - stay always in a distance

Stressed over what people says or think or do

Some people - praise 9 - crushed

Praise - cloud 9

Criticise - crushed

Cannot receive correction -
asso

Secure in what they do
You are as fully accepted as Jesus

healing and boldness in prayers
Romans 8:32

He who did not spare His own Son,
but delivered Him up for us all, how
shall He not with Him also freely
give us all things? NKJV

Pharisees not healed but tax
collectors and sinners

Pray - conscious of yr own r -
DOUBTS - long?

Fast? - never assurance - 6
More important - aware - REL
otherwise, conc wrong thing - way
you PRONOUNCE formula-
Praying on the BASIS
of Jesus' righteousness and
favour - nothing do - ADD - minus
Nothing you can do - add or minus
- favour - righteousness

Boldly - conscious - His
perfection covers our
imperfection - his fragrance
covers

Not conscious of our sins Heb 10:2

In Jesus - like going through a
FULTER - remove - add -
tell struggle

Our imperfections removed and
he

Adds his fragrance - made up
defects - motive,

Sing or pray - out of tune - OK
as long as - too loud disturb
others

Tell him - yr fear - struggles -
frustrations

Notice - are not
Notice that those areas that David
was honest to being before the
Lord, the Lord helped him
conquer all of it

But there is one area that David
didn't share to the Lord -
struggles with lust and that is the
area that he fell into sin.

3. Power to be transformed
Romans 6:14

For sin shall not be your
master, because you are not
under law, but under grace.
Worthy? Caught. Asked F?

Worthy? No - caught

Asked? No - offered

Proof yourself first - wo

Woman caught in adultery

Neither do I condemn, go and sin
no more

We normally:
Proof yourself first than I will
accept you

Was she transformed? SURE
Most amazing transformations:
forgiven much

Sin offering - not everyday
EVERYDAY - morn - nite -
thank you for Jesus - he is my
righteousness

True change is effortless - not
will power - inside out

If will power - required will
power to maintain it

God changes inside out

Gal 3:5

5 Therefore He who supplies the
Spirit to you and works miracles
among you, does He do it by the

works of the law, or by the hearing
of faith?

What is the thing that we should keep on
hearing that would make miracles in our
lives?

Ministers - releasing the blessings of
the Spirit - as you listen

Man lamed from birth - Acts 14 - as
Paul was preaching good news

Acts 14 9, Paul saw faith in the
man born lame, stand up - the
guy jump. No mention of Jesus'
name? How healed?

See more miracles? 7 words that
work miracles in yr life

Acts 14:7

7 where they continuingly
preaching the good news.

As listen - good news - Christ

Deli - healed - God does wonders
- armies

deli - bad habits

Body healed - God does wonders to
finances, business

Many times - Israel - armies reached
battle filed - enemies slain - just
gather spoils of war - Jehoshapat

As you listen - Go back - Mon -
find - enemy no more - vict in
sch - work place

Bitten - serpents - look to bronze
serpent

Bronze - judged
Serpent - sins

WORLD - 7 steps - 14 laws - got
to apply

Failed! - blame - didn't apply this
that (Prin6b pt 3) - forgot this that
- missed timing, fast or pray
enough

Bible - as words go forth - healed
1 Corinthians 1:23-24

23 but we preach Christ crucified: a
stumbling-block to Jews and
foolishness to Gentiles,

24 but to those whom God has called,
both Jews and Greeks, Christ the
power of God and the wisdom of God.

Good news – 7 words that can work miracles yr life – not **new** – fresh

1. Jesus arrived at Golgotha (Mt 27:33; Mk 15:22; Lk 23:33; Jn 19:17).

When Jesus arrived at

Golgotha – refused wine – mixed w myrrh - why

2. He refused the offer of wine mixed with myrrh (Mt 27:34; Mk 15:23).

A kind of **painkiller**. Jesus wants to suffer – **fullest** – **consciously** – that's what he came to do!

3. He was nailed to the cross between the two thieves (Mt 27:35-38; Mk 15:24-28; Lk 23:33-38; Jn 19:18).

I. Father forgive them

Luke 23:34

34 Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing."

And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.

If you want to **know** what a person really is – what inside – **observe** what he says or do – pain – real you – **real char** – **passion** – **Mel Gibson**

Board meeting – one spoke vulgar word – oh pas I don't mean it – not me – that's the real you

Guy – portraying Jesus – saw him taking those lashed – cinema tricks but one lash actually hit him accidentall – 4 letters

Jesus has one **passion** – forgive

Past – pre – **fut**, Oh – only past! ?

How can God even forgive our future sins?

On the **night** – betrayed – this my body

Already forgiven – bef you even commit

5. The soldiers took Jesus' garments, leaving Him naked on the cross (Mt 27:35; Mk 15:24; Lk 23:34; Jn 19:23).

6. The Jews mocked Jesus (Mt 27:39-43; Mk 15:29-32; Lk 23:35-37).

7. He ministered to the two thieves

2. Today you will be with Me in paradise

Luke 23:39-43

39 One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"

40 But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence?"

41 We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong."

42 Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

43 Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise."

Did the thief – have any chance – fulfill reqd of law – yet rewarded paradise

You receive what Jesus deserves!

How does knowing you receive what Christ deserves free you from control?

When you focus - **you** qualifying – you deserve – give **control** to d

D has a hold and control over your life

Yes – give – what abt this

– Yes, you give to the poor – charity – ch – but what about this that you done

But when you focus on –

receive what Jesus deserves – d has **no control**

D has no control over you

Expect good things – despite imperfection

So when d whisper – don't deserve pros – Morris –

Terrace - **101%**

you don't deserve – prosperity – Amen - agree 101%,

but I have a **problem** - I am **receiving** – what do?

Does **Jesus** – sure – rest case but **I have a problem** – I am receiving what Jesus deserves! What to do?

but does Jesus deserve – SURE - rest my case

D – deserve - only Morris – Terrace – I agree I don't deserve –

What to do – I am receiving what Jesus deserves, not receiving what I deserves

Old – **forgetful** – body don't function that well

- that is what Adam deserves – don't expect – **secular**

What Adam deserve

Don't expect to grow old the way others are

Even young man fail – wait – renew strength

Secular studies – church goes healthier – younger – live longer! Most vibrant love life! RC, charismatics

Not just **positive** thinking Basis – cross

3. Woman here is your son

John 19:26-27

26 When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Dear woman,

here is your son," 27 and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home.

Jesus cares – shepherd

See him as **shepherd** – not just almighty sovereign

– **love** – tenderness – intimacy

When have him as shepherd 23

Psa 23 - Not want

He **makes** me lie down

He **leads**

He **restores**

He with us and **comforts**- dark valleys

He **prepares** table – presence of enemies – don't have to fight

He **anoints** head – oil – don't have to defend

Always trying to defend – not know him as Shepherd – not feeling

Key – be **fed** –

look fresh manna

New **song** – mean fresh – not new

but a new look – many words – one word – joy – jump – lights up – that's rhema – word that the good shepherd speaks thru the under shepherds - **lay**

Darkness came from noon to 3 P.M. (Mt 27:45; Mk 15:33; Lk 23:44).

D took most **precious** – son – nailed him to cross – God took the cross – use it most unimaginable way (rent) - key to forgive all our sins

Share some of the ways God reverses situations in your life:

Isaiah 60:2

2 See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you.

– world darker – ch brighter

Amazing **brutality** – man advert

– net – eat human flesh – one

(educated computer expert) offered- first asked to eat his own hand – later

– allow chopped – freeze – eaten slowly all record – Video

Haggai 2:9

9 'The glory of this present house will be greater than the glory of the former house,' says the LORD Almighty. 'And in this place I will grant peace and prosperity,' declares the LORD Almighty."

4. My God My God why have you forsaken me

Matthew 27:46-47

46 About the ninth hour Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" - which means, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Galatians 3:13

13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

Hope – for last days

Malachi 4:6

6 He will turn the hearts of the fathers to their children, and the hearts of the children to their fathers; or else I will come and strike the land with a curse.

Able to play Marjong? – marble – closely knitted w kids

5. I am thirsty

John 19:28

28 Later, knowing that all was now completed, and so that the Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, "I am thirsty."

13. He drank "wine vinegar" (Jn 19:29).

15. He drank wine vinegar from a sponge (Mt 27:48; Mk 15:36). Hyssop stalk – Passover Exodus 12:22

22 Take a bunch of hyssop, dip it into the blood in the basin and put some of the blood on the top and on both sides of the door-frame. Not one of you

shall go out of the door of his house until morning.

Imagine the fountain of life – suffered thirst – that we may be satisfied

John 4:13-14

Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, 14 but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

Remember wo – well – noon – avoid gossip – 5 – 6

5th husb – one living with not husb – 6th met 7th man

Left water pot ?

John 7:38

38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."

6. It's finished

John 19:30

30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "It is finished." With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Finished – not sure meaning – found papyrus – tax doc – paid in full

Made sin

2 Corinthians 5:21

21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Hebrews 10:14

14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified [set apart]. NKJV

Had no sin – did he do any sin – but he received our sins - curse Do we hav any r? no – receive r

– did we receive blessings – yes Can meh? Judge paid rental – embarrass client

Why did Moses fail to enter the Promised Land?

Desert of Zin (flat) - Brought here to die

Struck the rock

Earlier – strike with rod - Now speak

Different rock – elevated rock

Hear now rebel (?)

God didn't call them rebel

Must we bring water – (Did God ask Moses – he himself)

Hear now – not sisi way

Twice - Watasima

Becos you didn't – honor me

1st rock – Horeb (desolate) – picture of Christ – stricken for our sins - once

1 Corinthians 10:4

4 and drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ. Heb 10:2

2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins.

Stop hitting yourself – for you sins – wife or kids

Gossips & speaking harsh -ve words – rob us of calling and inheritance – Tony

Quickest way to get blessing to bless a blessed man – quickest way to get a curse – curse a blessed man

7. Father into your hands, I commit my Spirit

Luke 23:46

46 Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.

17. He dismissed His spirit by an act of His own will (Mt 27:50; Mk 15:37; Lk 23:46; Jn 19:30).

Even in death – in control – life not taken from him (poor man – PASSION - tears) – dying of exhaustion in the crucifixion - he gave it up freely – voluntarily!

John 10:11

11 "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

Curtain torn into two

Precise moment – priest doing burnt offering

18. The temple curtain was torn in two (Mt 27:51; Mk 15:38; Lk 23:45).

19. Roman soldiers admitted, "Surely He was the Son of God" (Mt 27:54; Mk 15:39).

1 John 4:17

Love has been perfected among us in this [has reached its goal]: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. NKJV

John 19:34

34 Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus' side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water.

Jesus died – heart broken by our sins
